After the new development, the central, state and private universities like SMU, will not require prior approval or no objection certification (NOC) from AICTE along with their application to UGC for offering of undergraduate, postgraduate and postgraduate diploma programmes under Management, Computer Application and Travel and Tourism disciplines in open and distance learning (ODL) or online mode.

However, deemed to be universities will continue to require prior approval/recommendation/ NOC of AICTE for offering of such programmes, before submitting their application to the commission.

Advantages of Question Based Evaluation:

- No need of 3rd evaluation

In new evaluation system also, Re-evaluation is allowed as before, but will be done by a Single Senior Evaluator
