- 1. A meeting regarding Ph. D. Course Work was held on 30th December 2019 in the Office of the Registrar, SMU at 12:00 Noon.
- 2. Members present were :-

- 3. The following points were discussed and agreed upon by all the members present :-
 - (a) The total credit for Ph.D. Course Work will be as follows:
 - i. After passing Research Methodology University Examination: 4 credits
 - ii. After passing Subject Specific (name to be given) University Examination: 4 credits
 - iii. After passing CPE-RPE University Examination: 2 credits
 - iv. Additional related subject: 4 credits

OR

Two research related seminars: 4 credits

OR

Two research related workshop: 4 credits

OR

One research related seminar and one research related workshop: 4 credits

- (b) Ph. D. Course Work examination will be conducted twice in a year, once in the month of January and next in the month of July.
- (c) The list of eligible Ph. D. scholars for the Course Work examination along with the department attached and the name of the Supervisor will be communicated to the Examination Division of the Medical Campus by the Research Unit, SMIMS / SMU (Medical Campus).
- (d) The Course Work examination will be carried by the University for three subjects as follows:
 - i. Research Methodology: Total Marks: 100

(Internal Assessment: 50 and University Examination: 50).

- ii. <u>Subject Specific</u> (name to be given for the subject specific exam): Total Marks: 100 (Internal Assessment: 50 and University Examination: 50).
- iii. <u>CPE-RPE</u>: Total Marks: 50

(Internal Assessment: 25 and University Examination: 50).

Further, the University examination(s) for Research Methodology, Subject Specific and CPE-RPE shall be conducted out of 100, 100 and 50 marks respectively, which will be converted into 50, 50 and 25 for Research Methodology, Subject Specific and CPE-RPE respectively during the

(e) The question paper pattern will be as follows: -

For 100 marks paper:

- (i) The Subject Code will be generated as follows:
 - 2 Alphabets followed by 4 Digits
 - 2 Alphabets represent the concerned department, the initial first digit will be 5 which represent the Ph. D. course and the last three digits represent the subject.

It is the responsibility of the concerned department to generate subject code for the subjects. It is also the responsibility of the concerned department to give name to the specific subject.
